CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MRS. PEAP^r. A. WRIGHT

of Route 2, Box 262, Jacksonville, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Birch or Muddy Creek

a tributary of Left Fork of Little Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 12.0 acres, and domestic and stock use and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1890

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.30 cubic foot per second

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to Nelson Pursel and recorded at page 16409, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 15.0 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 3.0 acres was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered February 18, 1972. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Nelson Pursel.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
