## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That ALICE LAWSON

of Freewater, State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Johnson Creek and Hodgdon Creek and Goodman Spring Branch, after its confluence with said Johnson Creek and Hodgdon Creek for the purpose of the irrigation of 39 acres of land and domestic use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 466; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1894.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.75 cubic feet per second; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: 33 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 6 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Thirty, Township Six North, Range Thirty-five East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

(This right is subject to the rights of Wm. Records, W.S. Edwards, J.S. Hoskins, E. C. Kralman and Chas. Morrill to the waters of said Goodman Spring Branch.)

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
