CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. H. FREUDENTHAL

of Route 5, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 19.0 acres under Permit No. 20093 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 1, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Geo. Sigler DLC 42, Section 7, T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 2620 feet South and 450 feet East from SW Corner, Moore DLC 41.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.2 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Nowland DLC 68 +

5.5 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Sigler DLC 42 *
4.5 acres Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)

Certificate of water right issued to E. H. Freudenthal and recorded at page 22778, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 53.0 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 34.0 acres was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered February 25, 1972. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to E. H. Freudenthal.
