## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ERNEST O. WEBB and AGNES M. WEBB

of P. O. Box 74, Tygh Valley , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Buck Hollow Creek

a tributary of Deschutes River irrigation of 37.3 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 28518 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 10. 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.93 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE¼ NW¼, SE¼ NW¼, Section 2, T. 4 S., R. 14 E., W. M. Diversion points located: 2660 feet West and 180 feet South; 2790 feet West and 1940 feet South; both from NE Corner, Section 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
