## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This is to Certify, That** CARSON C. MASIKER, R.F.D. No. 1, Box 84  
of Hood River, State of Oregon has a right to the use of  
the waters of Neal Creek, a tributary of Hood River  
for the purpose of Irrigation, domestic and stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Hood River County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 469;  
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1895 for Tract No. 1; 1910 for  
Tract No. 2 and 1908 for Tract No. 3

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic feet per  
second for Tract No. 1; 0.05 cubic feet per second for Tract No. 2 and 0.02 cubic  
feet per second for Tract No. 3; and shall be subject to all other conditions and  
limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appur-  
tenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1; 11 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter of  
Section Thirty-six, Township Two North, Range Ten East of Willamette Meridian,  
in Hood River County, Oregon.

Tract No. 2: Hydraulic ram located in the Southwest quarter of Northeast  
quarter of Section Thirty-six, Township Two North, Range Ten East of Willamette  
Meridian, in Hood River County, Oregon.

Tract No. 3: 1½ acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter of  
Section Thirty-six, Township Two North, Range Ten East of Willamette Meridian,  
in Hood River County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
