## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That JACK and SONJA THOMPSON

of Route 1, Box 269, Hermiston , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of Umatilla River domestic use of one family and irrigation of 8.3 acres for the purpose of

under Permit No. 33718 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 2, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second for domestic and 0.19 cubic foot per second for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEW NWW, Section 20, T. 4 N., R. 28 E., W. M. Spring located: 360 feet South and 550 feet West from NW Corner, Section 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 8.3 acres NE% NW% Section 20 T. 4 N., R. 28 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
