CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOSEPH HERTEL

of Route 1, Box 83, Cornelius , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of East Fork Dairy Creek

a tributary of Tualatin River irrigation of 38.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 31383 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 28, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.48 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (SEM NEM), Section 4, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 1440 feet North and 150 feet West from SW Corner, J. Harrison DLC 38.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.1 acres SW/4 NE/4
5.4 acres SW/2 NW/4
25.7 acres SE/4 NW/4
1.3 acres NE/4 SW/4
0.1 acre NW/4 SE/4
All as projected within J. Harrison DLC 38
Section 3
T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
