CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHARLES S. MOORE

of Tall Timber Ranch, P. O. Box 398, Selma , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Reservoir constructed under application number R-4170, permit number R-4608

a tributary of Salt Gulch Creek (Deer Creek) supplemental irrigation of 29.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 30623 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 15, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 20.33 acre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWW, SWW, Section 7, T. 36 S., R. 7 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 360 feet South and 570 feet East from WM. Corner, Section 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of of one-cubic feet per-second per-acre, 3½ acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 20.33 acre feet per year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
