CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That WILLIAM A. SUNDAY

of Winona Lake, State of Indiana has a right to the use of
 the waters of Neal Creek, a tributary of Hood River
 for the purpose of Irrigation, domestic and stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Hood River County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 469;
 that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from March 1901

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes; and shall not exceed 0.45 cubic feet per
 second; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in
 said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appur-
 tenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:
 9 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 29 acres in the North-
 east quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-five, Township Two North,
 Range Ten East of Willamette Meridian, in Hood River County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
