## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This is to Certify, That** J. F. FLYNN, C. V. HAINES, HENRY BASSETT, JIM WALLACE  
 J. J. WOLFENPERGER, J. M. COLE, CLAY HILLS, LLOYD DUKE, Wm. MADDERN AND BESSIE WOODHOUSE  
 of Halfway, State of Oregon, has made proof  
 to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

East Pine Creek  
 a tributary of Pine Creek for the purpose of irrigation and domestic  
 under Permit No. 440 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters  
 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the  
 STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of  
 said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 447, on the 15th day of November, 1922;  
 that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 11, 1910

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
 aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
 5.26 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder for irriga-  
 tion shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is  
 appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is  
 as follows: 5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 20 acres in the  
 Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-nine; 25 acres in the  
 Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Thirty-two; 10 acres in the South  
 west quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-eight; 40 acres in the North-  
 west quarter of Northwest quarter; 20 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest  
 quarter; 38 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 30 acres in the  
 Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 10 acres in the Southeast quarter of  
 Northeast quarter; 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 20  
 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Thirty-three;  
 25 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter and 15 acres in the North-  
 east quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Thirty-four, Township Seven South,  
Range Forty-six; 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 35  
 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 40 acres in the South-  
 east quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Three; 40 acres in the Southwest  
 quarter of Northwest quarter and 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest  
 quarter of Section Two, Township Eight South, Range Forty-six, All East of  
 Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon. Containing in all 493 acres  
 of land.

The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall be limited to one-  
 eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of  
 use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from  
 the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under  
 the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby con-  
 firmed and limited.
