of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters G-4231 under Permit No. has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby July 16, 1968 confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream The point of diversion is located in the NWM NVM, Section 31, T. 2 S., R. 1 E., W. M. Well located: 1240 feet South and 790 feet East from NW Corner, Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2% acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 20.1 acres NWA NWA 40.3 acres SWM, NWM Section 31 8 T. 2 S., R. 1 E., W.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
