CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHARLES E. FRISK

of 21440 E. Evans Creek Road, Central Point, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of East Fork Evans Creek

a tributary of Evans Creek (Rogue River) for the purpose of irrigation of 10.0 acres

under Permit No. 29454 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 16, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, T. 34 S., R. 2 W., W. M. Diversion points located: 680 feet North and 570 feet East; 420 feet South and 30 feet West; both from SW Corner, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 1000 cubic feet per second immediately above Savage Rapids Dam and more than 735 cubic feet per second at its mouth,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.8 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
7.4 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
0.8 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 9
T. 34 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
