This Is to Certify, That JOHN E., BRUCE E., and WILMA D. HAGERTY

of Route 1, Box 148, Cloverdale , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Dawson Creek

a tributary of Nestucca River for the purpose of domestic use of four families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden each, stock, and use in dairy

under Permit No. 31737 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 24, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second, being 0.02 cubic foot per second for domestic, 0.01 cubic foot per second for stock, and 0.01 cubic foot per second for dairy

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE% NW%, Section 26, T. 4 S., R. 10 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 1500 feet South and 1830 feet East from NW Corner, Section 26.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic, stock SW/4 NW/4 Section 26

domestic, stock, dairy NW/4 NE/4
domestic SE/4 NW/4
Section 27
T. 4 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
