CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FLOYD HOFFMAN and DOROTHY HOFFMAN

of Route 4, Box 235, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring, an unnamed stream and two reservoirs constructed under application number R-43252, permit number R-4955 a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of domestic use of two families, stock, irrigation of 4.0 acres and fire protection

under Permit No. 32333 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 6, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second from spring for domestic, 0.01 cubic foot per second from spring for stock, 0.05 cubic foot per second from stream and north reservoir for irrigation and 0.01 cubic foot per * or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, T. 2 S., R. 3 W., W. M. Diversion points located: Spring - 60 feet South and 70 feet West; North Reservoir - 540 feet South and 1090 feet West; South Reservoir - 760 feet South **

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-4955,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic, Stock, Fire protection,
and 4.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 25
T. 2 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

* second from stream and south reservoir for fire protection.

** and 1210 feet West; all from N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 25.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
