CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

WILLIAM C. REMIOR

of Route 1, Box 62, Yamhill , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of two springs

a tributary of Yamhill River for the purpose of domestic use of one family including the irrigation of not to exceed ½ acre lawn and garden and irrigation of 4.0 acres

under Permit No. 32198 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 10, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 cubic foot per second for Spring #1 for domestic and 0.01 cubic foot per second from Spring #3 for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEW NEW, Section 2, T. 3 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Springs located: 570 feet South and 1300 feet West; 460 feet South and 650 feet West both from NE Corner, SM NEW NEW, Section 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.8 acres NE% NE% domestic 1.2 acres SE% NE% Section 2
T. 3 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
