Oregon State of , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of kolaila River

Willamette River for the purpose of Irrigation a tributary of under Permit No. of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the \cdot STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of 447, on the 15th day of November, 1922
December 8, 1909 said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1 , at page that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
