industrial (tanner) and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for P_{01k} County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 17, at page 90; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1863

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.18 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the NE½ NE½, as projected within J. Lyle D.L.C. 68, Section 32, Township 7 South, Range 5 West, W.M. (diversion point located below) A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Being within the tract of land described as follows: Beginning at a point which is 20 feet west from the northwest corner of Lot 2 in Block 3 of the lands formerly belonging to LaCreole Academic Institute in the Town of Dallas, and running thence west 35 links; thence N. 18° W. 1 chain and 93 links; thence N. 65° 30' W. 14 chains and 17 links; thence N. 13° 30' W. to Charles M. McDonald line in the middle of the channel of the LaCreole Creek, a distance of about 3 chains; thence along said line down the LaCreole to Charles McDonald's northeast corner in said stream, thence south on the east line of said Charles McDonald land to the first angle therein south of the creek; thence east 27.06 feet to the second angle from the creek; thence south 40.33 feet to the next angle on said line; and thence S. 12° 30' E. 188 feet along said east line to the place of beginning.

Diversion point located: 1,000 feet north and 2,800 feet east from SW corner J. Lyle D.L.C. 68

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
