and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 15 at page 461; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1866 - Tract #1 confirmed dates from 1876 - Tract #2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to Sept. 30; further limited to one acrefoot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and 3/4 acre-foot per acre thereafter; total five acre-feet per acre for season, measured at point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located in the NW NE NE , Section 26, T. 13 S., R. 30 E. NW SW SW SW Section 20, T. 13 S., R. 31 E.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to Frank N. Noble and recorded at page 25633, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 103.0 acres. The right to the use of water appurtenant to 11.2 acres was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered Merch 30, 1972. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Frank N. Noble.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
