

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. E. BARTLETT

of Route 2, Box 505, Grants Pass , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of irrigation of 2.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 17671 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 8, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 6 (NEZ NEZ), Section 26, T. 35 S., R. 7
W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.5 acres Lot 6 (NEX NEX)

Section 26 T. 35 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

Property on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described as follows:

Beginning at a point 314.6 feet East of the SW Corner, Lot 6, NEt NEt, Section 26, T. 35 S., R. 7 W., W. M., in Oregon; thence running North 368 feet; thence South 85 deg. 34 min. East 845 feet; to the westerly meander line of Rogue River; thence South 37 deg. 45 min. West along said meander line 376 feet; thence West 610 feet to the point of beginning.

Certificate of water right issued to J. E. Bartlett and recorded at page 17351, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 4.0 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 1.5 acres was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered August 23, 1972. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to J. E. Bartlett.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
