CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of 2032 2nd Avenue, Gold Hill , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean irrigation of 0.9 acre

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 8386 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 16, 1928

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEX SEX, Section 17, T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 650 feet North and 560 feet West from SE Corner, Section 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

U.9 acre SE% SE% Section 17 T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered December 30, 1970, and together with the certificate recorded at page 37375 supersedes contificate of water right heretofore issued to Soren Christensen and recorded at page 8249, Volume 8, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
