CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HERMAN HUEBNER

of Route 1, Box 317, Eagle Point, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of
irrigation of 40.0 acres
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1898;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
1.0 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, T. 35 S., R. 1 W., W. M.,
230 feet North and 70 feet West from S $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 31.
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

40.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 6
T. 36 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved
by an order of the State Engineer entered August 31, 1966, and together with
the certificate recorded at pages 34528 and 38307, supersedes certificate of
water right heretofore issued to Vida and Clarence Rankin, and recorded at
page 32722, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
