## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** M. T. BAKER

of Pilot Rock, State of Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of East Birch Creek

a tributary of Umatilla River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 10.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 3, at page 127; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1870;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.125 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 33, Township 1 South, Range 32 East, W.M., 330' N. and 2030' E. from the SW corner SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 33. A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.0 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 33  
Township 1 South, Range 32 East, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered November 20, 1964, and together with the certificate recorded at page 32152, Volume 24, supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to M. T. Baker and recorded at page 2486, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
