CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Peter B. and Mary Stadelman

of 1122 University Street, Walla Walla, State of Washington, has a right to the use of the waters of Ford Branch of Little Walla Walla River

a tributary of irrigation of 8.5 acres for the purpose of

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 12, at page 9; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1900 for 0.5 acre, 1905 for 2.0 acres and 1908 for 6.0 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half miner's inches per acre measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 26, T. 6 N., R. 35 E., W.M., 50' N. and 1295' W. from the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 26.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.5 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 26
Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M.

(NOTE: The water right for the acreage under date of 1908 is limited to use for season between October 15 of each year to June 1st of the following year.)

Certificate of water right issued to M. C. Lamke and recorded at page 12849, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 13.89 acres. A change in the point of diversion for the irrigation of 5.39 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered February 16, 1972. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to M. C. Lamke.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
