CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **BURT SMITH**

of 5862 S.W. Meadows Road, Lake Oswego , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Bonita Meadows Creek and ponds constructed under application number R-40405, permit number R-4648 a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of wildlife refuge

under Permit No. 30791 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 3, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Brown DLC 64, Section 7, T. 2 S., R. 1 E., W. M., Reservoir #1 - 490 feet South and 750 feet West; Reservoir #2 - 560 feet South and 790 feet West; Reservoir #3 - 620 feet *

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* South and 770 feet West; Reservoir #4 - 840 feet South and 850 feet West; all from N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 7.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
