CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FOREST GROVE LUMBER COMPANY

of P. O. Box 386, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Gales Creek, tributary of Tualatin River

for the purposes of

a log pond under Reservoir Permit No. R-5127 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 12, 1967 for 20.0 acre feet
February 16, 1968 for 5.74 acre feet

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 25.74 acre feet
