CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That VERNON E. LYDA

of Route 1, Box 351, Forest Grove , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed drainage way and reservoir constructed under application number R-41972, permit number R-4775, and West Dairy Creek a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation of 16.0 acres

under Permit No. 33308 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 23, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic foot per second to be diverted from drainage way and reservoir when available and any deficiency in the available supply from the unnamed drainage way and reservoir to be made up by appropriation from West Dairy Creek.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, T. 1 N., R. 4 W., W. M., Creek - 1470 feet North and 4630 feet East; Drain and reservoir - 370 feet North and 3030 feet East; both from W $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-4775,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.7 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
4.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.3 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
1.0 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 11
T. 1 N., R. 4 W., W. M

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
