CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JAMES F. and GLENNA H. CORSON

of Route 2, Box 361, Jacksonville, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Applegate Rivera tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
irrigation of 59.3 acres, domestic and stockand that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1876,that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
1.475 cubic feet per secondThe point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, T. 40 S., R. 3 W., W. M.A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as

Certificate of water right issued to James F. and Glenna H. Corson and recorded at page 36461, Volume 28, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for mining and irrigation of 61.0 acres, domestic and stock. A special order of the State Engineer entered December 9, 1969 canceled the right for mining. A change in the right to the use of water appurtenant to 1.7 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered May 18, 1972. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation, domestic, and stock and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to James F. and Glenna H. Corson.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
