## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** GEORGE W. DUNN

of Ashland, State of Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of Neil Creek

a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of  
irrigation of 54.63 acres  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1854;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.68 cubic foot per second

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as

Certificate of water right issued to George W. Dunn and recorded at page 15967,  
Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the  
use of water for irrigation of 58.43 acres. A change in point of diversion  
appurtenant to 3.80 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered  
August 8, 1972. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to  
the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore  
issued to George W. Dunn.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
