## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEORGE DIMEO

of 5030 S.W. 209th Avenue, Beaverton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Butternut Creek and reservoir constructed under application number R-43019, permit number R-4898

of tributary of Tuelatin River for the purpose of

a tributary of Tualatin River irrigation of 2.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 32162 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 10, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEX NEX as projected within Masters DLC 46, Section 14, T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W. M., Reservoir - 2810 feet North and 430 feet West; Creek - 2780 feet North and 80 feet West; both from SE Corner, Section 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-4898,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.9 acre SE% NE%
1.7 acres NE% SE%
Both as projected within Masters DLC 46
Section 14
T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
