CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That JOHN HANBY of Whitney, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Meadow Creek, a tributary of Burnt River

for the purposes of irrigation, water to be appropriated under permit No. 3323, certificate of Water Right, Recorded in Vol. 5, Page 3761, State Record of Water Right.

under Reservoir Permit No. 397 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 447, on the 15th day of November, 1922; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 12, 1917

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 40 acre feet.

The reservoir is located in Section 3, Tp. 12 S. R. 37 E W. M.
