CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of 1002 NE Holladay St., P. O. Box 3737, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Eagle Creek

a tributary of Clackamas River for the purpose of maintenance and operation of a Federal fish hatchery

under Permit No. 28681 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 27, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 34.0 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, T. 3 S., R. 5 E., W. M., North 50 deg. 38' West 498.3 feet from SE Corner, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
