CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That VIRGE BURTON and
ESTATE of JACK BURTON
of Route 1, Box 327, Beaver Creek, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under application number R-39759,
permit number R-3974
a tributary of Nate Creek for the purpose of
stock use

under Permit No. 29603 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from April 30, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.005 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, T. 4 S., R. 3 E., W. M.,
2000 feet West and 1700 feet South from NE Corner, Section 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

Section 10
T. 4 S., R. 3 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
