CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MABEL C. KUYKENDALL

of Route 1, Box 175 A, Yamhill , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the SIATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Yamhill River

a tributary of Yamhill River irrigation of 8.8 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 32787 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 2, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (NEt SEt), Section 6, T. 3 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 470 feet South and 2100 feet West from easterly SE Corner, Norris DLC 81.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.6 acre Lot 2 (SE\formula NE\formula)
0.2 acre SE\formula NE\formula
2.8 acres NE\formula SE\formula
Both as projected within Norris DLC 81

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
