CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **EDWARD HINES LUMBER COMPANY**
Grant County Division
 of **422 W. Main, John Day**, State of **Oregon** ⁹⁷⁸⁴⁵, has made proof

to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of **John Day River, tributary of Columbia River, appropriated under application number 46148, permit number 34477, in Edward Hines Pond #2**

for the purposes of **sprinkling log decks, fire protection, and operating boilers for steam vats**
 under Reservoir Permit No. **R-5487** of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **June 23, 1969**

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed **9.0 acre feet**
