Main, John Day , State of 076300 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of John Day River and Edward Hines Pond \$2 constructed under application number R-46147, permit number R-5487 a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of sprinkling log decks, fire protection, and operating boilers for steam vats

under Perinit No. 34477 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 23, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.92 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
