CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION
Landscape Section, Construction Division
of State Highway Building, Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
a well

a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of
general rest area use

under Permit No. G-3132 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from January 6, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.07 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Smith DLC 59,
Section 23, T. 38 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Well located: 1100 feet South and 280
feet West from N $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

use herein described.
