or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEX NWX as projected within Smith DLC 59, Section 23, T. 38 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Well located: 1100 feet South and 280 feet West from NX Corner, Section 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ---- of one cubic foot per second per acre,
