three wells

under Permit No. G-3837 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from September 18, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.58 cubic foot per second, being 0.15 cubic foot per second from Well #4, 0.33
cubic foot per second from Well #5 and 0.10 cubic foot per second from Well
#6.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Sterling DLC 55,
Section 15, T. 38 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Wells located: #4 - 970 feet South and
280 feet West; #5 - 860 feet South and 360 feet West; #6 - 810 feet South and *
The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
