CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JUNO HILL and HERBERT BIRD

of Box 570 A, Coos River Route, Coos Bay , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unusued stream

a tributary of Rast Fork Millicoma River irrigation of 1.0 acre and domestic use of two families

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 31225 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **March 10, 1966**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.013 cubic foot per second, being 0.008 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.005 cubic foot per second for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NEt NEt), Section 4, T. 25 S., R. 11 W., W. M., 930 feet South and 920 feet East from NW Corner, Lot 1 (NEt NEt), Section 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic and 1.0 acre SEk SEk Section 33 T. 24 S., R. 11 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
