of Route 1, Box 77V, Amity , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Wilson Reservoir constructed under application number R-43113, permit number R-4917

a tributary of Ash Swale irrigation of 21.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 32217 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 8, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 7.7 acre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW's NE's as projected within Townsend DLC 45, Section 13, T. 6 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 1100 feet South and 400 feet West from NE Corner, Ira S. Townsend DLC 45.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of of one cubic foot per second per second of 2½ acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
