CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JOHN H. HAMMEL

of **Parkdale**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **two unnamed springs**

a tributary of East Fork Hood River domestic use of two families

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 21015 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from Rovember 26, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 cubic foot per second from each spring

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the No. 1 - SEX SWX, and No. 2 - NEX SWX, Section 16, T. 1 N., R. 10 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE'x SW'x Section 16 T. 1 N., R. 10 E., W. M.

Property on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by applicant as follows:

Robert A. Herring Troperty: All of the SE $^{\frac{1}{2}}$ SW $^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of Section 16, T. 1 N., R. 10 E., W. M. except the W. 10 acres thereof.

John H. Hammel Property: Beginning at the SW corner of the SW SE% of Section 16, T. 1 N., R. 10 E., W. M., and running thence N. 208'; thence E. 208'; thence S. 208'; thence W. 208' to the place of beginning, containing 1 acre more or less.

This certificate is issued to correctly show the place of use and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to John H. Hammel and recorded at page 23762, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
