**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That HERMAN R. & HELEN HORNECKER**  
of **3125 SW River Road, Hillsboro**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof  
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of  
**an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under application number R-23261,**  
**permit number R-950**  
a tributary of **Rock Creek** for the purpose of  
*irrigation of 200 acres*  
under Permit No. **18494** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters  
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby  
confirmed dates from **September 20, 1948**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
**0.25 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$**  as projected within **Thomas Stewart DLC**  
**43**, Section 9, T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W. M., 2040 feet South and 1480 feet East from  
W<sup>est</sup> **Mer**, Section 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second  
*per acre*, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be  
further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre** for each  
acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and  
storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-950,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is  
appurtenant, is as follows:

**0.1 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$**   
**Section 8**  
**1.7 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$**   
**11.7 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$**   
**6.4 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$**   
**0.1 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$**

**All as projected within Thomas Stewart DLC 43**  
**Section 9**  
**T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W. M.**

This certificate is issued to correctly locate the place of use and supersedes  
certificate of water right heretofore issued to Herman R. and Helen Hornecker  
and recorded at page 23516, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates.  
The appropriation of water as allowed herein is limited to the terms and condi-  
tions of a stipulation between Catherine and Odlat R. Merrill and Herman R. and  
Helen Hornecker dated August 9, 1955, on file in the office of the State Engineer.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
