## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That F. C. SEXTON

of Hood River, State of Oregon 97031, has a right  
to the use of the waters of two springs

a tributary of Neal Creek (Hood River) for the purpose of  
irrigation of 1.2 acres, domestic and stock  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Hood River County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1, at page 469; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1871

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.02 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

domestic, stock, & 1.2 acres NE¼ NE¼  
Section 25  
T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to F. C. Sexton and recorded at page 3845,  
Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the  
use of water for irrigation of 21.1 acres, domestic, and stock. A change in  
the point of diversion for the irrigation of 19.9 acres was approved by order  
of the State Engineer entered February 27, 1967. This certificate is issued  
to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation, domestic,  
and stock and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to F. C. Sexton.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
