CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

Box 50, Oakland , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Calapooya Creek

Umpqua River a tributary of irrigation of 6.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 19747 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby September 21, 1950 confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the St, SWt SEt as projected within Stephens DLC 50, Section 15, T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation sesson of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 6.0 acres SW4 SE4 As projected within Stephens DLC 50 Section 15 T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Walter A. Davis and recorded at page 22680, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 26.4 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 20.4 acres was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered February 6, 1973. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Walter A. Davis.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
