CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

Drain Oregon , State of , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Elk Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 56.8 acres

for the purpose of

19749 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 2, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.71 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SET NET, Section 18, T. 22 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 955 feet North and 655 feet West from Et Corner, Section 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2% acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is 1.4 acres NEt NEt appurtenant, is as follows:

0.1 acre Lot 3 (NWt NEt)
3.4 acres NWt NEt
34.4 acres SWt NEt

Both as projected within Stillwell DLC 39
2.2 acres Lot 4 (SW% NE%)

12.4 acres SEt NET 0.3 acre NET NWT

2.6 acres SEk NWk

Both as projected within Stillwell DLC 39

Section 18 T. 22 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to George Churchill and recorded at page 22495, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 59.3 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 2.5 acres was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered December 1, 1970. A change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 56.8 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered February 4, 1971. This certificate is issued to confirm the change in point of diversion and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to George Churchill.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of

use herein described.
