that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second, being 0.0025 cubic foot per second from spring #1, 0.0025 cubic foot per second from spring #2 and 0.005 cubic foot per second * from spring #3

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEX SEX & Lot 4 (SEX SEX), Section 8, T. 30 S., R. 12 W., W. M., #1 - 50 feet North and 20 feet West; #2 - 3 feet South and 40 feet West; #3 - 400 feet South and 130 feet West all from ME Corner, *

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _______of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
