or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWL NEL as projected within Chambers DLC 53, Section 32, T. 6 S., R. 3 W., W. M. Well located: 450 feet South and 350 feet West from NE Corner, Chambers DLC 53.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,
