of Route 1, Box 180, Rickreall , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Mud Slough and duck pond constructed under application number R-47047, permit number R-5642

a tributary of Rickreall Creek waterfowl habitat

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 35188 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

June 5, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEX SEX, Section 17, T. 7 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 1500 feet North and 410 feet West from SE Corner, Section 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to the period of one cubic foot per second per-acre, from October 1 to January 31 of each year and shall be subordinate and inferior to all future rights for beneficial consumptive use,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NWk SEk SWk SEk Section 17 T. 7 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
