CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

LOUIS PALLIN

of Route 1, Box 294, Bandon , State of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Spring Creek

a tributary of Coquille River irrigation of 3.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 16583 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 11, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.30 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEX NEX, Section 20, T. 28 S., R. 14 W., W. H., 980 feet South and 940 feet West from the NE Corner, Section 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 0.1 of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.75 acre-foot for each acre irrigated in any 30-day period and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 6 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.0 acres SE% SW% Section 17 T. 28 S., R. 14 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: The East 15 acres of the No of the SEt of the SWt, Section 17, T. 28 S., R. 14 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered October 24, 1968, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to William Biescke and recorded at page 16783, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
