and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 15, at page 461 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1906

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to one acre foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and 3/4 acre-foot per acre thereafter; total five acre-feet per acre for season, measured at point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located in the NW NET, Section 27, T. 13 S., R. 29 E., W. M., 50 feet South and 3380 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 27. A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
